NEA RA delegates and guests are invited to a briefing by the U.S. Census Bureau staff to describe the Census In Schools [CIS] program for the upcoming 2010 enumeration of population. The session previews **CIS materials being mailed to every public school** across the country later this fall.

The briefing covers lesson plans and other teaching materials available from the Census web site and focuses on the key role educators have in ensuring a complete count.

NEA External Partnerships and Advocacy staff will provide additional details about NEA's partnership with the Census including targeting schools adjacent to "hard to count" populations, assuring confidential treatment of Census information, reaching non-English speaking communities in their home language, and ensuring **educators are represented on local Complete Count Committees.**

Participants will learn how an accurate Census count affects local school budgets, especially Title I and special education funding, as well as college tuition grant and loan programs. The 2010 Census results will determine how Congress is reapportioned and will impact redistricting of state legislatures, county and city councils and voting districts throughout the country.
