I actually have time to sit with them to talk without constantly fighting the battle of a excessively large, loud, class. My students are getting a better teacher this year. I feel like I am able to do so much more with them because there are less of them. Please cap the class sizes and if you're able to look at capping the prekindergarten and kindergarten class at 15-17 students. Those fewer students have made a world of difference and will surely have a positive impact on student academic and social emotional success.
