My daughters fourth grade class currently has 29 students. I am a teacher and am devastated that her learning is being impacted due to budget constraints. As I teacher I know that she has less opportunities to share her ideas with the class, to be seen in a small group by her teacher, to have her teacher give her individual attention. The behaviors that arise in the classroom due to student needs not being met are a further detriment to my daughters learning. Class size caps are needed because our students education is being jeopardized due to unnecessary budget cuts.
